




Q2 If you live in Sallisaw, how long have you lived here?

Q3 Which of the following best describes your current housing situation?



Q7 For which of the following destinations do you regularly stay in Sallisaw city limits to visit? (Select all that apply)





Q8 During weekdays during the day, do you typically...



Q9 During weekday evenings, do you typically...



Q10 On weekends, do you typically...



Q11 Which surrounding communities do you regularly visit when traveling outside of Sallisaw to meet your needs? (Select all that apply)






Q12 How often do you leave Sallisaw to meet your needs (work, job, childcare, groceries, etc.)? (Select all that apply)

Q13 How often do you leave Sallisaw to fulfill wants or desires (entertainment, dining, recreation, etc.)? (Select all that apply)



Q14 Looking ahead 20 years, which of the following should Sallisaw prioritize most? (Select up to 3 priorities)









Q16 Which types of housing are most appropriate and desirable in Sallisaw for future development? (Select all that apply)







Q18 What types of businesses would you most like to see more of in Sallisaw? (Select up to 5 priorities)











Q25 What is your gender?





Q27 What is your age?


